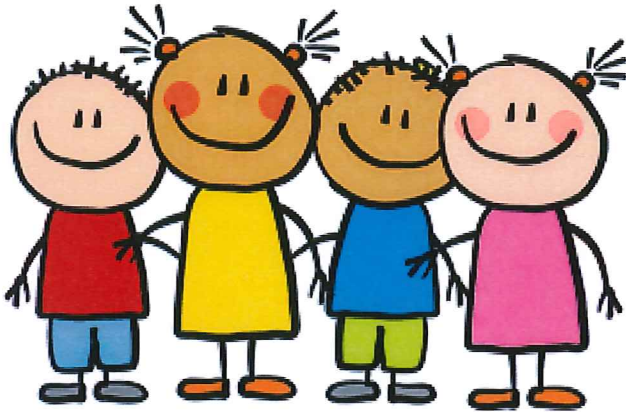


# Immunizations at the Health Department

## VACCINES FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN

*Protect your child against 14 diseases.*

- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B
- Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTaP)
- Pneumococcal (PCV13)
- Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)
- Polio
- Rotavirus (RV)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- Chickenpox (varicella)
- Influenza

## VACCINES FOR ADOLESCENTS

*Vaccines help teens stay healthy.*

- Meningococcal (MCV acwy & Men B)
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Tetanus-Diphtheria- Pertussis (Tdap) Booster
- Influenza

## VACCINES FOR ADULTS

*Adults need vaccines too!*

- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap) Booster
- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B
- Pneumococcal (PPSV23 & PCV13)
- Zoster (shingles)
- Influenza

## INSURANCE INFORMATION

BEDHD accepts most insurance plans, including Medicaid. Please check with your insurance company to ensure you have the appropriate coverage and that BEDHD is an in-network provider. If immunizations fall under your deductible and your deductible has not been met for the year, you will be responsible for charges incurred.

BEDHD participates in the Vaccines for Children program which allows uninsured and underinsured children vaccines at an affordable price.

Adults without insurance coverage may qualify for reduced cost vaccines when they meet certain eligibility factors.
