

Use of Children's Room

Are you new to the library?

Here are some helpful hints:

- Enjoy quiet activities that don't interrupt others, like reading, puzzles, and coloring pages. Please clean up when you're done.
- We have many things you can do with your child, but feel free to bring your own items, as long as they are not loud (like squeaky baby toys), or messy (like Play-Doh or paint).
- We have a changing station located in the women's and men's restrooms—**please change diapers in the restroom and not in public areas of the library.**
- **Drinks in covered containers are allowed, but there is no food allowed in the library.**
- Shoes are required even for little ones if they are walking.
- Please take and make all phone calls in the lobby.
- Our policy on attending to children is:
 - Children six years of age or younger must be *continually* attended by a parent or caregiver while in the library.
 - Children ten years or younger may not be left in the building without a responsible adult caregiver under any circumstance.
 - Children between the ages of ten and thirteen years of age may be left unattended for a maximum of two hours.
- Please leave by closing time—please be considerate of staff, who must perform closing procedures after you leave.
